Recreational trailer parking on driveways: permitted starting May 1

As we head into camping season, residents can enjoy the convenience of storing recreational vehicles on residential driveways. Here are some helpful tips you need to know when storing your recreational unit this season:

- A maximum of two recreational units may be parked/stored on a residential site at a time.
- Recreational units should not occupy or obstruct any required parking stalls.
- While parked, units cannot be used for sleeping, food preparation or personal hygiene.
- All recreational units should be located wholly within the site and be setback a minimum of 0.6 m from the rear property line where there is a rear lane.

As street sweeping begins, please be mindful of your community-scheduled cleaning and ensure all recreational trailers and vehicles are not blocking or parked on the effected roadway.

Weekly organics collection resumes

With the start of spring, Cochrane has resumed its weekly curbside collection of organics carts as of Monday, April 15, 2024. Residents can expect to have their household organics and yard waste collected on a weekly basis throughout the spring, summer and into fall.
