Upcoming Railway Crossing Closures: May 3-10

Canadian Pacific Railway (CPR) is removing the siding track at River Avenue, Centre Avenue and Fifth Avenue crossings. This project will improve the crossings and provide a pedestrian link on the East side of River avenue providing more connectivity.

This work is scheduled between May 3-10. Crossings will be closed one at a time, for two days each. Closure schedule will be shared in coming weeks.
