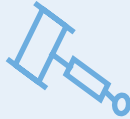

The residential street cleaning schedule is available in this week's paper and at cochrane.ca. Our road crews will visit each neighbourhood for a single day of sweeping outside of regular scheduled waste and recycling or organics collection days.

Residents can help by moving their vehicles by 8am on sweeping day.

Want to get rid of the winter debris on your driveway? Simply sweep it onto the street away from the curb and we'll scoop it up. Please do not leave it in heavy clumps, as the sweeper will not be able to pick it all up.

Please do not sweep gravel into catch basins as it backs them up and contaminates the receiving rivers and streams.
