

# Tips for Winter Cart Placement

- Find or clear a spot to put your carts. It's your responsibility to make sure there is appropriate space at the curb/roadway/alley.
- Carts should be no closer than three feet from parked cars or the other cart: an arm's length spacing between each cart.
- Please have your carts out for collection by 7 am.
- Keep carts off the travelled portion of the road so they don't interfere with snow plows.
- Do not place carts behind or on top of snow banks.
- Put carts as close as possible to the street or alley without obstructing the street or sidewalk. (Try one on either side of your driveway!)
- Clear your cart of snow and ice to ensure the lid opens when cart is tipped.

*In winter months, place your carts so the collection truck can reach them.*

**Good to Know** The automated arm on the collection truck can only reach eight feet from the truck!



Place waste and recycling carts on the street, not on top of snow piles.
