PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET

Our parks and pathways are for everyone. We appreciate the efforts of the volunteer Off-Leash Advisory Group (OLAG) who recently helped clean-up our local parks, but it is ultimately the responsibility of pet owners to clean up after their dogs.

To help ensure you don't miss a scooping, always keep your dog in sight and consider using a light-up collar for low-light (dawn/dusk) conditions.

Municipal Enforcement monitors our parks and pathways to ensure they can be enjoyed by all users.

Fines

- \$150: No suitable means to remove feces
- \$300: Failure to remove animal feces immediately

Fines double for feces not removed in playgrounds, tennis courts, cemeteries, school grounds and sport fields.

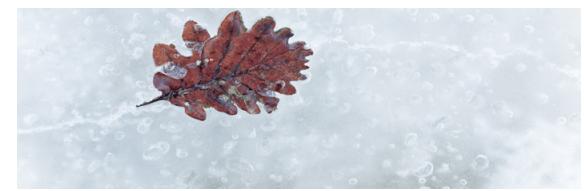

Any person who deems to be affected by the issuance of these permits may appeal to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board by 4:30 pm, February 27, 2020. On Permitted Uses, grounds for appeal must relate to questions of interpretation, variance, or relaxation, and not to the proposed use. On Discretionary Uses, all aspects of the proposed development may be challenged upon appeal. Written notice of appeal, accompanied by the appeal fee as established by Town Council, shall be filed through the Office of the Secretary of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board at 101 RancheHouse Road Cochrane, Alberta T4C 2K8.
