Notice is hereby given that the Development Authority has authorized the issuance of the following Development Permit(s) in accordance with the Town of Cochrane Land Use Bylaw #01/2004:

Permit No: DP2020-055

Legal Address: Lot 27, Block 25, Plan 951 1144
Municipal Address: 2 West Hall Place (Child Care Services – Daycare)

Type: Principal Dwelling – Variance of the Rear Yard Setback of Principal Building & Eaves
Use: Permitted with Variance

Any person who deems to be affected by the issuance of these permits may appeal to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board by 4:30 pm, June 4, 2020. On Permitted Uses, grounds for appeal must relate to questions of interpretation, variance, or relaxation, and not to the proposed use. On Discretionary Uses, all aspects of the proposed development may be challenged upon appeal. Written notice of appeal, accompanied by the appeal fee as established by Town Council, shall be filed through the Office of the Secretary of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board at 101 RancheHouse Road Cochrane, Alberta T4C 2K8.

WEED TREATMENT MAY - AUG

Town of Cochrane Parks is eradicating and controlling dandelions, prohibited noxious weeds and noxious weeds by mechanical and chemical means (per Town Noise and Nuisance bylaw and the Alberta Weed Control Act): intermittently from May through August, weather permitting.

Annual control of infestations is critical to the long-term prosperity of our natural vegetation. All due diligence for public safety and environmental impact are followed, including 48-hour signage. We recommend avoiding areas with signs for 24 hours after the posted application time and date.
